

The Presentation of Christ in the Temple (Candlemas) Purification of the Virgin Mary

The season of joyful celebration that begins at Christmas and continued through the successive Sundays of Epiphany, now comes to an end today with the Feast of the Presentation of Christ (Candlemas).

The child who has been manifested to the magi at his birth is now recognized by Simeon and Anna, when he comes to be presented in the Temple according to the Law of Israel. He is both 'a light to lighten the Gentiles' and 'the glory of God's people Israel'. But the redemption he will bring must be won through suffering; the Incarnation is directed to the Passion; and Simeon's final words move our attention away from the celebration of Christmas and towards the mysteries of Easter (which begins with Lent on Ash Wednesday, February 14th). Today in our liturgy we take the light of Christmas with our lighted candles into a world waiting to hear the Good News of Christ's Peace.
