In 2023, the theme is "mental health & well-being", and we are featuring projects that help with access to medical care both here and in our Link Diocese of Jerusalem.

Access to food is a common theme too, as worry about being able to feed the family leads to enormous stress, so we feature foodbanks here and nutritional gardens in our Link Dioceses in Zimbabwe.

Many too need support to deal with the pressures of life and we are asked also to support projects to facilitate well-being, by developing strategies to cope with the stress and mental illness caused by our modern world.
