can be worn. The first candle is lit on Advent Sunday and one on each Sunday thereafter, with the white one on Christmas Eve night/Christmas Day. Each of the four Sundays then reminds us of those who prepared for the coming of Christ - the Patriarchs, the Prophets, John the Baptist and Mary.
